To book an appointment, please go to <https://studybugs.com/speak> to login (please note - you cannot book this via the app). Once in, choose 'speak with a teacher' at the top of the screen, and select your child's name. You will see all the available appointments (dates & times) on the right hand side which will specify if they are online or in person slots. Once you have found a slot that works for you - click 'book'. You will be sent an email from studybugs with a summary of the details of the appointment and reminders 30 minutes and 5 minutes before. Please be aware that you will still receive an email with a link and reminders even with an in person appointment. We look forward to seeing you next week.
