Permission for use of Images

I appreciate that the digital age has moved on rapidly from when you originally signed a 'Use of Images' and 'Internet Permission' form. For the majority of you this would have been when your child started school. We reference these forms every time a child's image is published to ensure permission has been given. I have had a number of queries since starting the school *Twitter link so I feel it important that you are given an opportunity to update your preferences given that media has moved on. We have strict guidelines on how images are used – the conditions of use are included below for your information:

- 1. This consent form is valid for the period of time your child attends this school. The consent will automatically expire after this time.
- 2. We will not re-use any photographs or recordings after your child leaves this school.
- 3. We will not use the personal details or names (which means first name **and** surname) of any child or adult in a photograph on our website, in our school prospectus or in any of our other printed publications.
- 4. We will not include personal e-mail or postal addresses, or telephone or fax numbers on our website, in our school prospectus or in other printed publications.
- 5. If we name a pupil in the text, we will not use a photograph of that child to accompany the article.
- 6. We may include pictures of pupils and teachers that have been drawn by the pupils.
- 7. We may use group or class photographs or footage with very general labels, such as "a science lesson" or "making Christmas decorations".
- 8. We will only use images of pupils who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.
- 9. If images are taken by local press/media, or parents/guests, the school will not have control of these images.
